DID YOU KNOW?

- In 2017, US transplants reached a record high for the fifth consecutive year with 34,770 transplants reported.
- One organ and tissue donor can save up to 8 lives and restore health to over 75 others.
- Transplantable organs include: heart, kidneys, liver, lungs, pancreas and intestine.
- Transplantable tissue includes: corneas to restore sight, bone and ligaments to repair injuries, skin grafts to heal burns and for surgical reconstruction and heart valves to replace diseased valves.
- Most religions support organ and tissue donation.
- There is no cost to be an organ and tissue donor... donation is a gift.

115,000 people nationwide are waiting for a life-saving organ transplant.

Every day **20** people die waiting.

Nearly **4,000** New Jersey residents are waiting for a life-saving organ transplant.
